



IN SESSION BEHAVIOUR POLICY

This policy works in conjunction with the 'Dealing with Unacceptable Behaviour' section of the Codswallop CIC Child Protection and Safeguarding Policy (Page 4) and is designed to provide participants with an awareness of unacceptable behaviour. This policy outlines the steps the session team would take after the event/incident. 'Dealing with Unacceptable Behaviour' in the Codswallop CIC Child Protection and Safeguarding Policy details how the session team would handle the event/incident at the time of occurring.

Behaviour Policy

A '3 warnings' system will be put in place where if a participant were to behave in a manner that the session leader or session support worker feels is unacceptable, they will issue a 'Warning'. Upon the Participant receiving three 'warnings' in a term, contact will be made to the participants guardians to discuss the next steps. This could be missing the following session, leaving the group for the rest of the term/permanently, not performing in the sharing or no further action. This is in place to maintain a level of safety, respect and productivity for participants and staff within sessions

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
